Important Notification

EDIUS 6.5 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing for Grass Valley hardware driver installation. All versions of Windows 7 and Windows 8 / 8.1 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires the installation of TWO Security Updates on Windows 7 in order to install Grass Valley hardware.

They MUST be installed in the following order:

1. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3035131\)](#)
2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, EDIUS installer will ask you to install the security updates.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:

- EDIUS does not playback certain H.264 MOV clips correctly (Pro & Elite only).
- Blocking appears in an exported MPEG2 MXF clip if it is exported using the segment encoding option (Pro & Elite only).
- Line noise appears while playing the timeline if a circle transition is applied.
- EDIUS cannot import certain MP3 files.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved between 6.55.3480 and this version:

- Audio track does not appear if a clip, or clips, captured by STORM Mobile is/are placed onto the timeline (Pro & Elite only).
- DVD menu item does not have the same name as the sequence marker comment.
- Crosshatching appears on a timeline clip if a speed effect is applied with a certain rate.
- Auto-save project file is generated that cannot be opened.
