New Features of Version 7.41b28

This update provides the following additional features for EDIUS Elite only:

- Panasonic AVC-Intra 4K 422 file export support
- New integrated launcher for using EDIUS with GV STRATUS
- Export different formats to different destinations within STRATUS send
- Permissions for user groups & individual users to access K2 bins & specific assets
- K2 4K CMF file import support

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version.

Audio and video does not synchronize while editing a K2 growing file

Description: If a K2 GXF growing file is loaded onto the timeline via FTP, audio and video does not synchronize (EDIUS Elite only)

Burned DVD has movie title with incorrect duration

Description: If a chapter item is used for the background movie of a motion menu, the chapter duration is incorrect on the burned DVD

EDIUS fails to transfer certain P2 clips

Description: EDIUS fails to transfer any P2 clip that does not have audio data

Hardware encode option appears in non-supported environment

Description: The “Use Hardware Encoder” option appears in file exporter, even if Intel HD graphics is not running

EDIUS exports XDCAM EX clip incorrectly to JVC memory card

Description: If you select a JVC SDHC memory card in the XDCAM EX exporter, EDIUS writes the XDCAM EX clip with an incorrect folder specification to the card

EDIUS cannot play certain audio files

Description: EDIUS cannot play 24-bit wave audio files

Switching full-screen preview on/off causes EDIUS to freeze

Description: EDIUS freezes if the full-screen preview on/off toggle is switched frequently

KNOWN ISSUES

Analysis of Stabilizer effect always runs as a normal priority job

Description: Video analysis for the Stabilizer effect always runs as a normal priority job, even when set to run as a background job

Workaround: None

EDIUS imports proxy clip as a normal asset

Description: When a proxy file is created using the Create Proxy menu in the Bin, and the asset folder is then chosen to load the clip into the Bin, EDIUS imports the proxy file as a normal resolution asset

Workaround: None

Playback of exported XAVC S clip stops on output monitor

Description: If the timeline is exported to an XAVC S file using Superfine video quality settings, playback of the file stops on the video output monitor.

Workaround: Choose Normal or High Speed video quality settings in the XAVC S file exporter.

DESIGN LIMITATIONS

Projects are cleared from the Most Recently Used list

Description: When upgrading to EDIUS 7.40 or later, recent projects that were displayed in the startup screen are cleared from the list (but are NOT deleted from the PC). **NB: this limitation does not apply when updating from 7.40 to 7.41 and subsequent updates**

Workaround: None
