## Important Notification

EDIUS 7 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing for Grass Valley hardware driver installation. All versions of Windows 7 and Windows 8 / 8.1 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires the installation of TWO Security Updates on Windows 7 in order to install Grass Valley hardware.

They MUST be installed in the following order:

1. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3035131\)](#)
2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, EDIUS installer will ask you to install the security updates.

## Update History

*The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:*

- Marker that points to an XDCAM clip disappears when the clip is transferred. (SFDC00486084)
- User profile randomly disappears. (SFDC00493724)
- Intel Quick Sync Video hardware encoder does not work correctly when printing to file. (SFDC00488081)
- Field order and pixel aspect are incorrect when importing certain H264 MP4 clips. (SFDC00502566)
- EDIUS cannot load growing MXF file. (SFDC00505200)
- Video shift while playing uncompressed 10-bit AVI. (SFDC00494566)
- Timeline cursor moves backwards several seconds while playing a growing file. (SFDC00490460)
- Link to GV STRATUS is lost if EDIUS Elite opens an existing project file (EDIUS Elite with GV STRATUS only) (SFDC00483498)
- Outpoint is set unexpectedly if EDIUS ingests clip onto K2 storage. (SFDC00495375) (EDIUS Elite only)
- EDIUS sends a quit command when disconnecting from an FTP session.

## Update History

*The following issues are fixed or improved between 7.50.228 and this version:*

- Font kerning does not work correctly if a title clip is created using the Helvetica font. (SFDC00493862)
- Corrupted video playback at transition points. (SFDC00493325)

- Soft edge does not work in the Layouter for a dissolve effect on the timeline. (SFDC00492666)
- Edge noise appears if a SMPTE transition is applied. (SFDC00487670)
- Clip unexpectedly becomes offline in a field editing project. (SFDC00490457)
- Read-only project overwrites the auto-saved project file. (SFDC00489027)
- STORM Pro cannot capture SDI-embedded audio. (SFDC00491886)
- Project auto-save fails if the destination is not accessible. (SFDC00490444)
- SDI audio noise is output from STORM Pro when switching between Rec and Player windows. (SFDC00486611)
- EDIUS cannot import a K2 clip if its bin name ends with a period. (SFDC00490414)

## Known Issues

### **Stabilizer analysis always runs as a normal priority job**

*Description:* Video analysis for the Stabilizer effect always runs as a normal priority job, even when set to run as a background job

*Workaround:* None

### **EDIUS imports proxy clip as a normal asset**

*Description:* When a proxy file is created using the Create Proxy menu in the Bin, and the asset folder is then chosen to load the clip into the Bin, EDIUS imports the proxy file as a normal resolution asset

*Workaround:* None

### **Playback of exported XAVC S clip stops on output monitor**

*Description:* If the timeline is exported to an XAVC S file using Superfine video quality settings, playback of the file stops on the video output monitor.

*Workaround:* Choose Normal/High Speed quality settings in the XAVC S file exporter.

## Design Limitations

### **Projects are cleared from the Most Recently Used list**

*Description:* When upgrading to EDIUS 7.40 or later, recent projects that were displayed in the startup screen are cleared from the list (but are NOT deleted from the PC). **NB: this limitation does not apply when updating from 7.40 to subsequent updates**

*Workaround:* None
